



Sister M. Frederica, formerly Anna Deubig of Galion, OH, daughter of Philip Deubig and Catherine Baumgartner, died at the Motherhouse, St. Francis Convent, Joliet, IL, on Wednesday, July 20, 1949, at about 2:15PM in the 72nd year of her age and the 56th year of her religious life, having been fortified by the rites of the Church. Coronary occlusion was the immediate cause of death. Chronic myocarditis and coronary arteriosclerosis were associated diseases.

Anna Deubig entered as a postulant on July 6, 1893, became a novice on January 11, 1894, made first vows on September 8, 1896, due to postponement because of typhoid fever. Sister Frederica made her final vows on August 15, 1899. She celebrated her Golden Jubilee on June 23, 1946, along with Sisters: Aegidia, Michelina, Pauline, Amata, Hugoline and Nemesia.
