SISTER M. AGATHA DILLON

145. APRIL 7, 1926

Sister Camilla wrote this account:

"On April 6, 1926, at 4:10 in the afternoon, Sister Agatha departed this life in her 63rd year and the 48th of her religious life. She was anemic during her life and in consequence was of unusual paleness and subject to spells of sleep which would overtake her even in the classroom. Due to this she was very slow mannered and had a seeming indifference. On the night before her death she suffered a convulsion. A clot had settled in her heart and she never returned to consciousness. Rev. Theodore anointed her about 3:15 in the afternoon. Dr. A. Fahrner had camphor oil injections given to her and ice put on her heart. Sister Eugenia was sent a telegram but did not get here on time. Present at Sister Agatha's death were Sisters Dionysia, Columba, Walburga and Camilla."

Olivia Dillon was born to Charles and Hannah Kale Dillon on August 12, 1863, in Belle Fontaine, OH. Both parents were from Chambersburg, PA. Olivia entered the postulancy from St. Peter Parish, Mansfield, OH, on July 15, 1876. She became Sister Agatha on August 29, 1878, professed her First Vows on January 17, 1880 and her Final Vows on her 20th birthday, August 12, 1883. Her sister, Sister Eugenia, professed Final Vows on August 20, 1879 when she was in her 20th year.
