Sister Leocadia Dirnberger

On November 6, 1901, Sister M. Leocadia, formerly Catherine Dirnberger of New Hamburg, Missouri, died in the Motherhouse at Joliet in the twenty-eighth year of her age and the tenth of her religious life. Sister Leocadia was a full sister of Sister Gonzaga and Sister Angelica and was the youngest of the three. She was a simple and obedient religious, not minding the affairs of others, but attending diligently to what had been entrusted to her. She taught in the primary grades and was much beloved by her pupils.
