Sister Fulgentia Felder OSF

Sister M. Fulgentia, formerly Clara Felder, died of Spinal Meningitis at St. Joseph's Hospital, Joliet, Illinois at 4:15 p. m. She was a full sister to Sister M. Julitta and Sister M. Consilia.
