Sister Francisca Feldhake

On February 20, 1906, Sister Francisca, formerly Anna Feldhake, of Sigel, Illinois, died at the Motherhouse in the thirty-ninth year of her age and the eighth of her religious life.

After the expiration of her first year's novitiate, Sister Francisca was employed as a teacher for some time in which work she was very successful and she^{was} much beloved by her pupils. She was also much endeared to her religious companions because of her gentle and unassuming manners. In the summer of 1903 signs of failing health became apparent and she was obliged to go to the infirmary where she was a model of patience and resignation up to her peaceful death. Reverend A. J. Pennartz of Sigel, Illinois, officiated at the obsequies.
