Sister Marciana Fouser, baptized Catherine, was born in 1897 to Wilhelmine and Henry Fouser in the Bridgeport neighborhood of Chicago. She entered the Congregation in 1913 and began her teaching career already as a novice at Holy Cross School in Joliet. She remained active in the Illinois and Ohio school systems until 1973, when she retired from classroom teaching. St. Peter's in Mansfield, Ohio was always a very special "home" to Sister Marciana and she remained in the parish doing her own very special style of pastoral ministry until returning to the Motherhouse in Joliet in 1977.

During all of her active years Sister Marciana was involved in the service of God's children through her teaching and early learning activities. In an article in the Mansfield News Journal written in 1963 when she was chosen teacher-of-the-month by the Chamber of Commerce, it was said of her, "A teacher who has taught 31 years of kindergarten and first grade knows all the answers, especially about first graders."

Sister's love for prayer, her love for her religious vocation, and her love for people shows itself in her cheerful attitude toward life. Sister is always ready for a good laugh."

Marcy is remembered with fondness and love by her sisters, friends, the OLA staff and by all of those who easily came to love and appreciate her warm humor and sense of joyful simplicity.
