Sister Alfrieda Hanus

Sister M. Alfrieda, formerly Mary Hanus of St. Wenceslas
Parish, Chicago, died of tuberculosis on December 24, 1905, at the
Motherhouse at Joliet in the twenty-fourth year of her age and the
sixth of her religious life. Sister Alfrieda possessed an amiable disposition and her congeniality was such as to win the love and esteem
of her religious companions as well as her pupils in the schools where
during her short career she labored quite successfully. Her health
began to fail in the summer of 1905 and up to the time of her death she
remained at the Motherhouse.
