Dear Sisters,

Our Sister Roselma Hein has gone to her eternal reward.

Sister was born in Chicago on October 27, 1902, received the Habit on August 12, 1923, and was in the 47th year of her religious life. She died at 20 minutes past noon today at Our Lady of Angels, fortified with the Last Sacraments.

Sister was at St. Paul's, Joliet, when she became very ill last night and was taken by ambulance to Our Lady of Angels at 9 p.m. Her sole survivors, two cousins, Mr. and Mrs. L. Biedermann of Crystal Lake, Illinois and Mr. and Mrs. J. Allain of Mobile, Alabama, were notified, but were not able to arrive in time. Sister Grace Brouch was the attending nurse and said that Sister was conscious to the very last.

Sister Roselma's professional training was in Languages at the Universities of DePaul, Loyola, Northwestern, St. Louis, and Wisconsin. She spent a summer at Laval University in Quebec.

In her years of service from 1924 to 1967 she served as teacher in primary grades (St. Joseph's, Freeport, 1924-1925), intermediate grades (St. Mary's, Columbus, 1925-1926), and in secondary education from 1926 until 1967, teaching French, German, Spanish and Latin. Many of Sister's summers were spent at the College of St. Francis, teaching French.

The greatest number of Sister's years of service were spent in Ohio where Sister taught at St. Mary's, Columbus, from 1926 to 1931, at Central Catholic High School, Toledo, from 1931 to 1957, and at St. Peter's, Mansfield, from 1958 to 1967.

Sister was Superior and Principal at St. Clement's from 1948 to 1950. Her last years were spent at St. Paul's, Joliet, where she was engaged in private tutoring.

The Mass of the Resurrection will be sung on Saturday, February 28 at 10 a.m. at Our Lady of Angels. Burial will be at Resurrection Cemetery in Lockport.

May we recommend Sister Roselma to your prayers.
