In the death of Sister M. Paul Hoffman, the Community sustains the loss of one of its oldest members. Sister Paul departed this life at St. Francis Convent at 5:55 p.m. on December 13, 1927. Gathering infirmities took a decided turn for the worst and pneumonia brought on death.

Born in Offenbourg, Missouri, March 10, 1855 she entered the Franciscan Congregation at Joliet, Illinois on January 10, 1870 and was admitted to the simple vows on July 16, 1873.
