Sister Casimir Jazdzewska, OSF

On February 2, 1907 Sister M. Casimir, formerly Frances Jazdzewska of St. Stanislas Parish, Chicago, died of tuberculosis at the
Motherhouse in Joliet in the twenty-fourth year of her age and the
sixth of her religious life. She was mild in disposition, pious,
modest and reserved. Having taught but a short time in primary departments, she was obliged to desist from all educational work because of
failing health. She departed this life perfectly resigned to God's
Holy Will.
