Sister M. Bernarda, formerly Mathilda Jonik, died on July 23, 1968, at 12:40 a.m., in her 88th year and the 71st of her religious life. The cause of death was carcinoma of the bladder. Funeral services were held at Our Lady of Angels Retirement Home, Joliet, IL, at 10 a.m. on July 25, with burial in Resurrection Cemetery, Romeoville, IL.

Mathilda was born on May 20, 1881, in Koenigschutte, Germany, to John and Mary Novak Jonik. She became a naturalized citizen of the United States through her father in 1890, since she was a minor. On August 20, 1896, she entered the postulancy from Sts. Peter and Paul Parish in Chicago. She became Sister Bernarda on August 2, 1897, when she began her Novitiate. She professed her First Vows on August 15, 1899, and her Final Vows on August 12, 1905. She celebrated her Golden Jubilee in 1949, and Diamond Jubilee in 1959.

Four of her sisters became members of the community after her: Sister Tharsilla, who died in 1951, living sisters in age order are: Sisters Gerarda, Beata, Seraphia. A niece Sister Michael Marie is also a member of the community.
