



Sister Euphemia Kort.e

Sister M. Euphemia, formerly Elizabeth Kort.e, daughter of Henry Kort.e and Mary Schumacher, died on September 1, 1931 at 8:45 a.m. of cancer, at the Motherhouse, Joliet, Illinois, in the fifty-first year of her age, and the thirty-third year of her religious life.

Until infirmities obliged her to withdraw from community activities, she was ever ready to render her services as a humble domestic worker to all her Sisters. Sister Euphemia was very cheerful despite her sufferings. She found her joy and consolation in prayer. Very often she was found in the chapel before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament as the only adorer.

Requiem Mass was celebrated for Sister Euphemia in the convent chapel on September third. The services began at nine o'clock. The Reverend Eligius Weir, O.F.M. was the celebrant and also officiated at the obsequies. Sister was buried in St. John's Cemetery, Joliet.
