Sister Gerarda Loeffler

On July 6, 1897, Sister M. Gerarda, formerly Christine

Loeffler of Portsmouth, Ohio died of appendicitis after an illness of only three days at St. Boniface mission house, Chicago,

Illinois. This sister was a convert to our faith before she entered religious life. Hers was the vocation of Martha, in which

state she was indeed a model for all sisters attending to the

duties of housekeeping. She was usually spoken of as "dear Sister Gerard" by the different superiors with whom she lived. Never

was an unkind word heard from her lips by her co-laborers. Both
her superiors and her equals loved and respected her for her amiable and docile character. One can say of her that she was a worthy daughter of the humble St. Francis. At the time of her death
she was in the forty-first year of her age and the twentieth of
her religious life.
