Sister Patricia McDermott

Sister Patricia McDermott died at St. Joseph's Hospital, Joliet, Illinois, on May 9, 1928, after a goiter operation. She was in the fifty-fifth year of her age and in the thirty-seventh year of her religious life.

She was born in Columbus, Ohio. Her parents then moved to Joliet and have been parishioners of St. Mary's for many years. Sister was occupied as a teacher in the various parochial schools for thirty-five years.

She was buried on Saturday, May 12, 1928 at 8:30 a.m. from the Motherhouse Chapel. The Rev. Gratian Gehrig, O.F.M. chaplain, was the celebrant at the Solemn Requiem High Mass, assisted by the Rev. J. T. Farrell of St. Mary's Church, Joliet, as deacon and the Rev. Francis Bellerive of St. Raymond's Church as subdeacon. Her remains rest in St. John's Cemetery.
