

62. Sister Isabella Moran  
August 3, 1903

N. B. Very little information was recorded in the annals:

“On August 3, 1903, Sister M. Isabelle, formerly Elizabeth Moran, of Neoga, Illinois died of tuberculosis at the Motherhouse in Joliet, in the thirty-second year of her age and the fifteenth of her religious life. Most of her religious career was spent in parochial school work.”

From other sources we have this information:

Elizabeth Moran was born to Peter Moran and Margaret Keck on January 14, 1872.

Elizabeth entered the Congregation from St. Patrick parish, Neoga, Illinois highly recommended by her pastor and her physician, in July, 1888. She became a novice in 1889 with the religious name of Isabella and was sent to teach in Bayfield, Wisconsin. She was professed on August 12, 1891 when she was 19 years old. Her missions included:

She is buried in St. John Cemetery, Joliet, IL.
