Sister Rosemary Onderko

This evening at 10:10, Sister Rosemary Onderko died at Our Lady of Angels. Sister had been brought to OLA on April 4th. At the time she was losing the sight of both eyes. Her condition became progressively worse. She was in a coma for over a week, prior to her death. On the evening of her death, the Sisters prayed at her bedside from 8:30 until death was pronounced at 10:10. Sister did not regain consciousness.

Sister Rosemary was 61 years of ages on the 15th of August. She was in her 46th year of religious life. During that life she taught in Pennsylvania, Chicago, Cleveland, Joliet, Streator, Leonore, Elgin and Bayfield. Her last assignment was the Guardian Angel Home to which she was assigned in 1959, and from which she entered OLA in April. Children from the Home attended the funeral services on September 4th. The delay in the funeral arrangements was due to the fact that Labor Day occurred on the 3rd.
