Sister Mary Sabina, formerly Cora Otter of Mattoon, IL, daughter of Joseph Otter and Ellen Long, died at Wesley Memorial Hospital, April 27, eleven days after surgeons had discovered a very involved brain tumor. Sister Sabina was in the 66th year of her life and the 50th of her religious life.

Sister Sabina was admitted as a postulant on September 9, 1899, entered the novitiate on March 6, 1900, made first vows on August 15, 1902, and final vows on August 15, 1908. Her years on mission include:
