Sister Beatrice Raway

On March 3, 1912, Sister M. Beatrice, formerly Josephine Raway of Farmington, Wisconsin, died of Typhoid fever at Saint Joseph's Hospital, Ashland, Wisconsin in the thirty-fifth year of her age and the nineteenth of her religious life.

The peculiar manner of this Sister's call to the religious state has already been narrated. Her religious career was spent chiefly as teacher in parochial schools where she did very satisfactory work and in which she was engaged in Bayfield when she was taken ill. The symptoms of the disease became at once so alarming that she was immediately transferred to the Ashland Hospital. In spite of all care and attention given her she never again rallied but remained unconscious up to her death.
