SISTER M. FERNANDA RYAN 456. AUGUST 21, 1969

Sister M. Fernanda, formerly Catherine Ryan, died at St. Joseph Hospital, Joliet, IL, on August 21, 1969, at 10:05 a.m. Her death was hastened by injuries suffered during an automobile accident on August 4, 1969. The autopsy listed massive pulmonary embolism as the chief cause of death. Sister Fernanda was in her 69th year and the 53rd of religious life. Funeral services were held in Our Lady of Angels Chapel at 10 a.m. on August 23, 1969, followed by burial in Resurrection Cemetery, Romeoville, IL.

Catherine was born on January 18, 1901, in Mansfield, OH, to Dennis and Catherine Miller Ryan. She entered the postulancy from St. Peter Parish, Mansfield, September 7, 1916. Catherine became Sister Fernanda on August 12, 1917, when she began her Novitiate. She pronounced her First Vows on August 12, 1919, and her Final Vows on August 12, 1922.

Sister Fernanda earned her Bachelor of Music Education from DePaul University, Chicago, IL, in 1937, and a Master of Arts degree in Music from Northwestern University Evanston, IL, in 1957. She also studied various musical instruments at Conn National School of Music, Chicago, IL, before beginning her degreed programs.

Sister Fernanda celebrated her Silver Jubilee in 1944 and her Golden Jubilee in June, 1969, about than two months before she died. Most of her years in religious life were devoted to music and drama. She served:

The National Childrens' Theatre Foundation honored Sister Fernanda by donations in her name to further the education of teachers of children's dramatics. Fernanda composed dramatic productions for her students as well as directing the presentations. Her many years of tireless work with the children is preserved in photographs of her productions.

Sister Fernanda had undergone surgery for multiple enlarged masses of the thyroid gland for which a bilateral sub-total thyroidectomy was done in June, 1961. For many vears she had suffered from arthritis.
