Sister Mary Hieronyma Schubert, O.S.F., died at 5:20 p.m. on Saturday, October 10, 1970, at Our Lady of Angels Retirement Home in Joliet, Illinois.

Death came moments after Sister had delivered a feastday card to Sister Borgia and returned to her own room. Sister Grace was with her when she died.

One niece and a grandnephew survive: Mrs. Henrietta Ernst of Chicago, Illinois; Mr. Edmund Ernst of Oak Lawn, Illinois.

Sister Hieronyma was born on September 10, 1890, in Chicago, Illinois. She entered our Congregation in 1914 and made her first vows on August 12, 1916.

The primary grades were Sister's apostolate from 1915 until 1955. Sister taught in St. Ludmilla School from 1924 until 1954.

Prior to 1924, Sister taught in St. Procop School, Cleveland, Ohio; St. Stephen School, Johnstown, Pennsylvania and seven years in SS. Cyril and Methodius School in Chicago.

In 1954 Sister Hieronyma went to St. Procopius, Chicago, where she taught Grade 1 from January until June.

Sister Hieronyma assisted in general work at the Mother-house for a few years and returned to St. Ludmilla Parish in 1959 as receptionist and school assistant. Sister remained in this position until 1965.

Sister retired to Our Lady of Angels in the summer of 1965.

The Liturgy of the Resurrection will be celebrated at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, October 13, 1970, at Our Lady of Angels. Burial will be in Resurrection Cemetery, Lockport, Illinois.

Sister Hieronyma met death with great peace and readiness. We celebrate her life and death and final resurrection and give thanks to the Lord for her presence among us.
