Dear Sisters,

At 10:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 28, Sister M. Angelita Schwind quietly entered into Eternal Life. Sister had been very sick for the last week, so death was not a surprise.

Sister was born on October 9, 1895, in Columbus, Ohio, the daughter of John Schwind and Augusta Ranz, both of Germany. She was baptized at St. Mary's in Columbus and also confirmed in the same parish by Bishop Hartley. On September 7, 1915, she entered our Congregation as a postulant and professed her first vows on August 12, 1919. Three years later, in 1922, she professed her final vows. Sister celebrated her Golden Jubilee in 1969.

Her years of religious life were spent ministering as a homemaker until 1965, when she retired at Our Lady of Angels and then ministered through prayer and suffering. Her career as homemaker began in the Fall of 1918 at St. Francis de Sales in Chicago. She spent a total of 19 years working at various parishes in Chicago. Other places of ministry for Sister were: Columbus, Mansfield, Shelby, and Worthington in Ohio; Joliet, Leonore, and Pesotum in Illinois; and Bayfield, Wisconsin.

Sister Angelita is survived by one sister, Christine Schwind, of Columbus, and two nieces, both of Columbus. Her religious sister, Sister Leonette, a member of our Congregation, preceded her in death in 1937.

We invite her relatives and friends to join with her Franciscan Congregation to celebrate her entrance into eternal life at a Eucharistic Liturgy on Thursday, January 30, at 4:30 p.m. at Our Lady of Angels.

We are grateful for the many years Sister Angelita spent with us as our Sister.
