On December 18, 1896, Sister M. Francisca formerly

Cecilia Sorn of Chicago, died in the Motherhouse at Joliet in
the thirty-third year of her age and the tenth of her religious life. Sister Francisca was a practical housekeeper and in
that capacity proved herself of valuable service in working among
and in training the Indian girls in domestic work in our Industrial school at Bayfield, Wisconsin, where she had been for some
years engaged. It may truthfully be said of Sister Francisca
that she was a model religious from her entrance into the novitiate to the time of her death.
