Sister Theodora Steichler

Sister Theodora Steichler who had celebrated her Golden Jubilee on June 25, 1927, died at St. Elizabeth Hospital, Chicago, Illinois of Cerebral Apoplexy. She was in the sixty-seventh year of her age and the fifty-first year of her religious life.

She was born at Hettigen, Baden, Europe. She taught in several of the Chicago schools. St. Francis Xavier was the last assigned school at which she was stationed eleven years.

The funeral was held from St. Francis Xavier Parish on March 17, at 10:00 a.m. A Solemn Requiem High Mass was celebrated by the pastor, the Rev. Edward Goldschmit, assisted by Rev. Albert Korthals and Rev. Father Wagner as deacon and subdeacon. Rev. Martin Weidner was master of ceremonies. Sister Theodora was buried in St. Mary's Cemetery, Chicago.
