

SISTER M. SARCANDRA TESAR

Mary Tesar was born to Wenceslas and Anna Zrny Tesar in Budweiss, Czechoslovakia, on August 30, 1876. Her family emigrated to the United States and her father's naturalization certificate was dated October 19, 1880. Mary became a postulant in Joliet with an excellent recommendation from her pastor of St. Wenceslas, Chicago, IL. She became Sister Sarcandra in 1898 and professed her First Vows on August 15, 1900.
