Sister Teresa Yochem

On the day following Sister Helen's death, Sister Teresa, formerly Eva Yochem, of St. Joseph's Parish, Galion, Ohio, died at the Motherhouse in the twenty-first year of her age and the third of her religious life.

Sister Teresa possessed a blithesome nature and in her ambition longed to do much for the Community and for her neighbor. After having taken simple vows she was given a task in St. Procop's School, Chicago, in September where she taught only two weeks when her health began to fail. It was now learned that a cold she had contracted during the previous year had never quite left her. Her condition, however, was a puzzling one to the physicians who were consulted, her appearance indicating no wasting disease, and she was brought to Joliet where all remedies proved unavailing.
