Sister Urban Zglinske

Sister M. Urban Zglinske died Sunday, July 15, 1923 at 3:30 PM in the fifty-second year of her age and in the thirty-third of her religious life. She was unconscious during her last hours; attended by Rev. Leo Kalmer, OFM, who administered Extreme Unction to her and said the prayers of the Church for the dying.

July 18th Solemn Requiem by Rev. Karthals of Immaculate Conception Parish, Kankakee, IL, where she was last employed in domestic work; interment in St. John's cemetery by Rev. Karthals and Rev. Nicholas.

She had been brought home on a stretcher and taken to St. Joseph's hospital. There she remained for weeks. Feeling a little better she was brought to the Motherhouse. She lived however only days longer. Cancer of the stomach caused her death.

Domestic work had been her share of the Convent labors and this she always accepted in humble obedience and performed with cheerfulness. Even when weakened by exhaustion because she could not retain any nourishment, she constantly expressed her readiness to do work at least on some small mission.
