## Sister De Sales Aschemann

On February 25, 1928 Sister De Sales Aschemann departed this life at 11:12 a.m. in the seventy-third year of her age and the fiftieth of her religious life. She died of chronic myocarditis.

Sister De Sales was a native of Quincy, Illinois. She entered the novitiate of the Franciscan Congregation on May 9, 1878. For many years she was in charge of the Convent Chapel, then having spent a number of years on mission, she again was assigned to the Motherhouse where she spent her last years in various capacities. At the time of her death she was in charge of Sister M. Barbara Waniata who was mentally afflicted. On this unfortunate sister, Sister De Sales bestowed a mother's love and care.

The funeral of Sister De Sales was held from the Motherhouse chapel on Tuesday, February 28, 1928. Solemn Requiem High Mass was sung by Rev. Eligius Weir, OFM, assisted by Rev. Donulus Evers, OFM, and the Rev. Roman Hasenstab, OFM. Interment took place at St. John's Cemetery.
