Dear Sisters,

Sister M. Rosalinda Bueker died at 7:55 p.m. on Saturday, March 21, at Our Lady of Angels Retirement Home.

Sister remained alert and responsive until the last minutes before her death in the 92d year of her life and the 73d of her religious consecration. With her at the time of her death were her three cousins: Sister Rosita Renschen, Sister Marie Therese Kaufman, and Sister Georgine Deters.

Sister Rosalinda is also survived by one sister: Miss Mabel Bueker who resides in Los Angeles, California, and a sister-in-law: Mrs. Carl Bueker of Farmington, Michigan.

Born in Lillyville, Illinois on October 28, 1878, Sister Rosalinda entered the Congregation in 1896 and made her first vows in 1899.

Her many years of service to the Sisters as homemaker began in 1898 at St. Francis Assisi, Chicago. Sister Rosalinda gave sixteen years of her religious life as cook at the Motherhouse. She also served at SS. Peter and Paul and St. Boniface in Chicago; St. Joseph, Freeport; St. Mary's Institute in Bayfield, Wisconsin; St. Joseph's in Pesotum, Illinois; St. Mary's and St. Mary Magdalene's in Columbus, Ohio; Annunciation, Aurora, Illinois; St. Michael, Sigel; St. Francis Academy and St. Jude's in Joliet.

In 1961 Sister Rosalinda went to Our Lady of Angels as an infirmary patient, and remained there until her death.

The Liturgy of the Resurrection will be celebrated on Tuesday, March 24, at Our Lady of Angels at ten a.m. Burial will be in Resurrection Cemetery in Lockport, Illinois.

We give thanks for the long life of service Sister Rosalinda has given to us, her Sisters.
