Sister DePaul Casey

Sister M. De Paul, teacher of the fourth grade at St. Joseph's Austrian school died at St. Joseph's hospital late Saturday night (June 21, 1919) after a three day illness with typhoid fever.

This morning pupils and teachers of St. Joseph's school paid their last tribute to the nun as she lay in state in the chapel of St. Francis Academy.

Sister M. DePaul was born 21 years ago in Mansfield, Ohio. Casey was her family name. She came to the Joliet motherhouse as a postulant four years ago and had been teaching in St. Joseph's school a year.

Her mother, sister and brother arrived in time for the funeral which was held from St. Francis Academy at 3 o'clock on June 23, 1919. The Rev. Father Nicholas, OFM, officiated. Burial was in St. John's cemetery.
