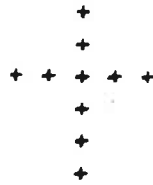


38. Sister Irene Garlick

Sister M. Irene, formerly Mary Garlick of Joliet, Illinois departed this life on February 6, 1895. She had been a sufferer from chronic catarrh which eventually terminated in consumption. Her long and painful illness was a severe trial which she accepted from the hand of God with entire resignation to His Holy Will.

Being in a weakened condition she, while sitting up in a chair, was overcome by a fatal swoon and thus expired. She was in the thirty-eighth year of her age and the thirteenth of her religious life.
