

SISTER M. NARCISSA GETZOVA

130. JULY 9, 1921

Sister Narcissa, Anna Getzova, was born on June 18, 1874, in Pribram, Czechoslovakia, to Aloysius and Mary Goklova Getzova. She died in her 48th year and the 27th of her religious life. Sister Narcissa died after surgery for gall bladder removal in St. Anthony Hospital, Chicago, IL. At her request her remains were brought to Joliet for burial in St. John Cemetery.

Anna entered as a postulant on July 17, 1894. She began her Novitiate as Sister Narcissa on July 2, 1895, professed her First Vows on August 11, 1898, and Final Vows on August 12, 1904, at the age of 30.
