Dear Sisters,

On the eve of the Feast of the Assumption, 1973, Sister Edward Marie Jordan was called to Heaven at 6:50 p.m. after eating supper with her Sisters in Our Lady of Angels community.

Sister entered the Congregation on September 8, 1924 and made final profession on August 12, 1930. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in Education in 1939 and a Master of Arts degree in 1949 from De Paul University.

Her professional life began at St. Joseph's, Joliet. She taught business subjects at various high schools of the Congregation: St. Peter's, Mansfield; Sts. Peter and Paul, Chicago; Marybrook Academy, Maumee; and St. Francis Academy, Joliet. She retired to Our Lady of Angels in 1967.

Sister was born the daughter of Edward Jordan of County Mayo, Ireland and his wife, Honore Peyton of County Mayo, also. Both are now deceased. With her two sisters she came to America, became a citizen and lived in St. Clement's Parish, Chicago.

Surviving are two brothers, Michael Jordan of Leicester, England and Patrick of County Mayo, Ireland.

The Sisters of the Congregation are invited to be present at the Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Edward Marie on Thursday, August 16, at 7:30 p.m. In this way we celebrate Resurrection with Sister Edward Marie. The Funeral Mass will be Friday, August 17, at 10 a.m. at Our Lady of Angels. Burial will be in Resurrection Cemetery in Lockport, Illinois.
