Sister Sophia Jungblut

Sister M. Sophia Jungblut died on this date, Saturday night, at 11:40, in the sixty-sixth year of her age and in the fifty-first of her religious life, having been fortified by the rites of our Holy Mother Church. Solemn Requiem: Celebrant, Rev. Remigius, OFM; Deacon, Rev. Nicholas Christoffel, OFM; Subdeacon, Rev. Thomas Tormey, St. Raymond's. Burial on August 29 at St. John's Cemetery.

So, after festivities of Golden Jubilees, reception, profession and laying of the cornerstone of the new Academy, August 20, reaper Death threw a cloud over the joyous affairs, by claiming the victim pointed out by the Most High to be his. Though she had been ailing for some time yet she assisted our little Sister Melania, Wencellas, Chicago, in the kitchen and dining room. On returning home in early August, she said to Sister Camilla "Oh it is no longer nice to live in this world!"

When in the infirmary she was ever cheerful, tried any remedy that was suggested. Before her death she ordered pancakes and apparently enjoyed some of them.

She died of Chronic Myocarditis, Dilation and Mitral insufficiency. (Dropsy)
