



Sister Mary Lioba, Antoinette Kalal of Chicago, IL, daughter of Francis Kalal and Anna Zaunt, died at the Motherhouse. She was born in Czechoslovakia, (Slabcice, Pisek, Bohemia), on July 13, 1881. She emigrated with her family to the United States, Chicago, when she was an infant. After being a postulant in the Congregation from August 15, 1902, Sister Lioba began her novitiate on February 24, 1903, making First Vows on July 31, 1905, and Final Vows on August 12, 1911. She died in her 69th year and 47th year of her religious life. Sister Lioba was the youngest of 12 children and the last of her generation to die.
