

SISTER M. ALBERTINE KONGORSKI
263. JULY 25, 1945

Sister Albertine, formerly Regina Kongorski, daughter of Frank and Rose Kowalski Kongorski (natives of Damran, West Prussia, Germany) was born on July 31, 1878, in Chicago, IL. Regina entered the community as a postulant from St. Boniface Parish on July 20, 1897. She entered the Novitiate on March 25, 1898, as Sister Albertine, and professed her First Vows on August 15, 1900, and Final Vows on August 15, 1906. Her natural sister, Sister Leonore, was professed in 1913 and was eleven years younger in the family.

Sister Albertine died on Wednesday, July 25, 1945, at 6:45 a.m. CDT, at St. Francis de Sales Convent, Chicago. Her death was due to carcinoma of the colon and anemia as a contributory cause. She was in her 67th year, the 48th of her religious life.

The Solemn Requiem Mass was celebrated in St. Francis de Sales Church, at 10 a.m., on Friday, July 27. Rev. John Wester, the pastor, was celebrant, and was assisted by Rev. Matthew Fischer, assistant pastor as deacon, and Rev. D. A. Diedrich, pastor of St. Maurice Church, Chicago, as subdeacon.

Burial was made in St. Mary Cemetery, Evergreen Park, Chicago. Rev. John Wester officiated at the grave. Rev. Fischer and Rev. Diedrich were present.
