Sister Magdalen Lukasek

Sister M. Magdalen, formerly Rose Lukasek of St. Procop's Parish, Chicago, died of tuberculosis at the Motherhouse on Aug. 9, 1908 in the thirty-ninth year of her age and the twenty-second of her religious life. She spent a number of years in parochial school work where she gave much satisfaction. Having become unable to continue teaching because of feeble health, and being a skilled seamstress, she devoted the remainder of her time to sewing.
