

SISTER M. LIBERATA NAMPEL
115. DECEMBER 9, 1918

Sister Liberata, Emma Nampel, the only daughter of Joseph and Elizabeth Muller Nampel, was born in Freeport, IL, on May 26, 1884. She was raised on a farm with her six brothers. Emma entered as a postulant on January 8, 1903, became Sister Liberata, as a novice in 1904, professed her First Vows in 1906, and her Final Vows in 1912. After a very brief life in the community, she died of pneumonia at St. Elizabeth Hospital, Chicago, IL. At her family's request she was buried in St. Joseph Cemetery, Freeport, IL, on December 12, 1918.
