



Sister Assumpta Pavlos

Death summoned another victim the morning after Sister Angelica's funeral. Sister M. Assumpta Pavlos died of pulmonary tuberculosis on Thursday, March 30, 1933 in the twenty-third year of her age and the fifth of her religious life. After making her temporary profession Sister had been sent out to teach. She had spent only the first year and a few months of the second year in the classroom when she had to be brought to the infirmary of the Motherhouse. She was confined to the infirmary until the day of her death.

She was buried in St. John's Cemetery, Joliet. Rev. Aloysius Fromm, OFM celebrated the Solemn Requiem Mass assisted by Rev. Roman Hasenstab, OFM., and Rev. Pascal Rollmann, O.F.M.
