

SISTER M. PASCALINE RIEGEL

116. DECEMBER 10, 1918

Sister Pascaline, Emma Riegel, was born on December 2, 1889, to John and Maria Brucnik Riegel in Joliet, IL. She entered the postulancy from St. John the Baptist Parish, on January 15, 1906, and became Sister Pascaline when she began her Novitiate. She professed her First Vows on August 12, 1909, and her Final Vows on August 12, 1915. Sister Pascaline died of influenza eight days after her 29th birthday. At the time of her death she had been missioned at St. Mary Institute, Bayfield, WI. Her remains were returned to Joliet for burial in St. John Cemetery on December 12, 1918.
