Sister Perpetua Spotanska

On June 4, 1905, Sister M. Perpetua, formerly Apollonia Spotanska of Radom, Illinois, died of tuberculosis at the Motherhouse at Joliet, Illinois in the thirty-eighth year of her age and the eighteenth of her religious life. She was a full sister of Sister Leona whose death was recorded in 1895. Like her sister she was a model religious and always considerate and kind in her dealings with her companions. She was quite successful as a primary teacher as she possessed the qualities necessary for gaining both the attention and affection of her pupils. She bore her trying illness with calm resignation and died a quiet and peaceful death.
