Dear Sisters,

On the first Sunday of Advent, December 2, 1973, Sister Henry Waldschmidt closed her life here on earth at 3:00 p.m. to begin her eternal Christmas in heaven.

Sister entered the Congregation in 1915 and made final vows in 1920. She celebrated her Golden Jubilee in June, 1967. Her teaching career was mainly in the elementary schools, beginning in Holy Cross school, Joliet. Many years she spent at St. Peter, Mansfield, St. Stephen, Johnstown, Most Pure Heart of Mary, Shelby, St. Boniface, St. Clement, and SS. Peter and Paul in Chicago. She retired to Our Lady of Angels in 1968.

Sister, the daughter of Henry Waldschmidt and Marie Fuchs Waldschmidt, was born in 1895 in Metamora, Illinois. She is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Catherine Ehringer of Metamora, and Mrs. Anna Kirchgessner of Peoria, and one brother, Henry Waldschmidt of Rock Falls, Illinois. Sister Aquinata, who resides at Our Lady of Angels, is a cousin.

Burial will be at Resurrection Cemetery, Lockport, Wednesday after 10 a.m. Mass at Our Lady of Angels. The Mass of Resurrection will be celebrated the previous evening at 7:30 p.m.
