Sister Barbara Waniata

Sister M. Barbara, formerly Miss Catherine Waniata, daughter of Wenceslas Waniata and Frances Krolachwill died at the Motherhouse on February 23, 1930 at 10:00 p.m. of Chronic Myocarditis and Chronic Bronchitis. Sister was in the seventy-eighth year of her age and in the forty-first year of her religious life.

A solemn Requiem High Mass was celebrated for the repose of her soul on Wednesday, February 26, 1930 in the chapel of the Motherhouse. The Rev. Louis Johantges, O.F.M., was celebrant, assisted as deacon by Rev. Claude Rust, O.F.M., and Rev. Roman Hasenstab as subdeacon.
