Sister Herbert Weber

Sister M. Herbert, formerly Margaret Weber, daughter of John Weber and Barbara Jarding, died of the effects of an operation (removal of the left suprarenal gland) at St. Anthony's Hospital in Chicago, Illinois, June 12, 1929 at 7:30 P.M.

Sister Herbert was in the forty-first year of her age and the twenty-second year of her religious life.

The funeral Mass celebrated at St. Francis Assisi Parish in Chicago, where she had been engaged as teacher of the 7th and 8th grades. The celebrant of the Mass was the Rev. Dominic Zaldivar, C.M.F., pastor, assisted by Rev. U. Julien, C.M.F., as deacon, and Rev. Joseph Puigvi, C.M.F., as subdeacon.

In the sanctuary were present the Rev. Gratian Gehrig, O.F.M. Rev. Arthur Terleke and Rev. Adalbert Janda, O.S.B. The school children sang the Requiem Mass.

At the request of her mother, the remains were taken to Joliet and buried in St. John's Cemetery, Rev. Louis Johantges, O.F.M. Chaplain, officiating.
